The exhibition was opened in November 25 on Albert Huet Square in Sibiu and will be on display in the city until 24 January 2024. The event was designed in two steps: 1) the public debate aimed at bringing the history of the Holocaust into to the present and making the discussion about the past relevant for current challenges. Two representatives of the students who participated in the creation of the graphic novel exhibition were invited among the speakers in order to emphasize the relevance of the young generation and to empower their voice in the public narrative. The debate was hosted by the Samuel von Brukenthal National College; and 2) the vernissage of the graphic novel exhibition for Sibiu district. Diplomas were awarded to the students who participated to the creation of the exhibition and their coordinating teachers.
